
# DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY WITH FCC RULES FOR ELECTROMAGNETIC COMPATIBILITY

We, Square Connect, Inc., located at 5960 Stoneridge Drive, Pleasanton, CA 94588, declare under our sole responsibility that the device, SQ Blaster, part #: SBQ001 complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules.



Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) this device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation. Caution: Exposure to Radio Frequency Radiation

The device shall be used in such a manner that the potential for human contact normal operation is minimized. repair facility and of such estimate shall be borne solely by the purchaser. Damaged equipment must remain available for inspection until the claim is finalized.
